# **BOOK REPORT POSTER PROJECT**

The students have learned all about the important elements of fictional stories. Now, they get to put their knowledge to work by creating a 'Book Report Poster' for their favorite fiction story! **This project will be due on the first day of school**. Ten points will be deducted each school day for projects turned in late.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- I.) Select a fictional storybook to complete your 'Book Report Poster' on. You can choose a picture book or a chapter book. You may use a book from home or a book from the library.
- 2.) Purchase a poster board and plan your project think about how you want your finished poster to look and what materials you will need to make it.
- 3.) Create your poster using the attached graphic organizers. You can use the attached organizers to write your information and organize it, but then create your own version to display on your poster in a more creative way. Just make sure to include everything!

- **Illustrations / Pictures**: Add a picture (drawn, painted, printed from the internet) that you feel best represents the story. **(20 points)**
- **Quality & Effort:** Please try your best on this project and turn in work you are proud of. **(5 points)**
