Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Is it mandatory that my child wear a mask in school?

Yes, the Governor adjusted this guidance on Monday, August 3rd. Students are now mandated to wear masks through the school day. They may remove the mask to eat lunch, and to take drinks of water. Please see more information that is provided in the link under #3.

Will there be field trips this year?

The guidance from the Department of Education is to NOT plan any field trips at this time. Therefore, we will not be scheduling any off campus events even those scheduled for the Spring until we receive updated guidance.

How many days are the students going to be in the building?

Four: M,Tu,Th,F. Wednesday is virtual for all students and staff so that a deep clean can take place.

If I chose virtual learning for my student can they switch to in person?

Yes, on November 10, as stated in the reopening plan.

If I chose in person learning for my student can they change to virtual?

Yes, after written notice is submitted to the CSA and approved as identified in the reopening plan.

Can I borrow a chromebook for my student(s)?

Yes, please reach out to our technology coordinator and the CSA to make this request.

Where can I find a supply list for my student?

Supply lists will vary by grade, subject and teacher. Please reach out directly to you child's teachers for a supply list. We will be limiting supplies and manipulatives as students will not be permitted to share.

Can my child bring their own water bottle to school?

Yes, all water fountains will be closed except for the two bottle filling stations in the building.
